Why study Performing Arts?

This course is for students who enjoy singing, dancing or acting on stage.

The course covers skills development in these areas and business practice.



What skills will I gain from studying Performing Arts?

You will develop skills in dancing, singing, acting, choreography and business. You will work as part of a team whilst preparing for shows.

Your confidence will increase as you take part in many performances.

How will I be assessed?

The BTEC is assessed through observations of practical work and written assignments. All performances are recorded and an external verifier visits from BTEC to confirm the marks given by your teacher.

Where can Performing Arts lead?

On completion you can progress to college or university to further develop your skills. Alternatively you can work in the industry through auditions.

What subjects link well with Performing Arts?

- Media studies
- Business Studies

What will I study?

BTEC Award: The course has two mandatory units – Performing to an Audience and Musical Theatre Performance. In addition to these units, another 3 units are studied which have a focus of dance, drama or music.

BTEC Certificate: The course has three mandatory units – Performance Workshop, Performing Arts Business and Performing to an Audience. In addition to these units, another 8 units are studied which have a focus of dance, drama or music.
